Zishka moved up well during most of the race to place 20th overall in the Championship field. McCray likewise ran a strong second half of her race to place 46th overall. The Division I race included over 120 runners. Both runners finished good seasons and ranked among the top athletes in central Ohio.

Lancaster Girls Place Third At OCC Cross Country Championships - Zishka earns All-OCC

The Lancaster Girls Cross Country team ran their best team race of the year to finish third overall at the OCC Cross Country Championships last Saturday at Hilliard Bradley. Coach John Zishka said that the team has made steady progress this season and began eyeing a top three league finish about two weeks ago. "We thought a realistic goal was to finish in the top three in the conference meet. The girls were really focused and ran well. I am very proud of them."

Sammie Zishka paced the Lady Gales with a 2nd place finish overall and earned First Team All-OCC. Savannah McCray finished in 8th place, Kellie Arter placed 15th, Aubrey Tobin finished 32nd, and Kayla Culbertson placed 35th to round out the scoring for the Lady Gales. Also running in the Team race was Marikate Evans and Sarah Cruit.

In the OCC Open race, Michelle Cotterman and Lindsey Eveland competed for the Lady Gales.
